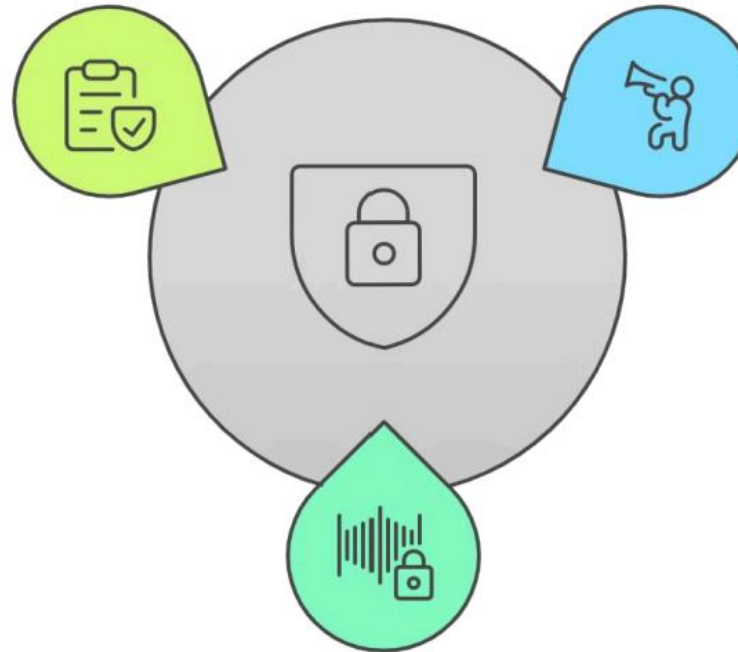
Pillars of the Strategy

GRC standards are promoted to improve cybersecurity posture.



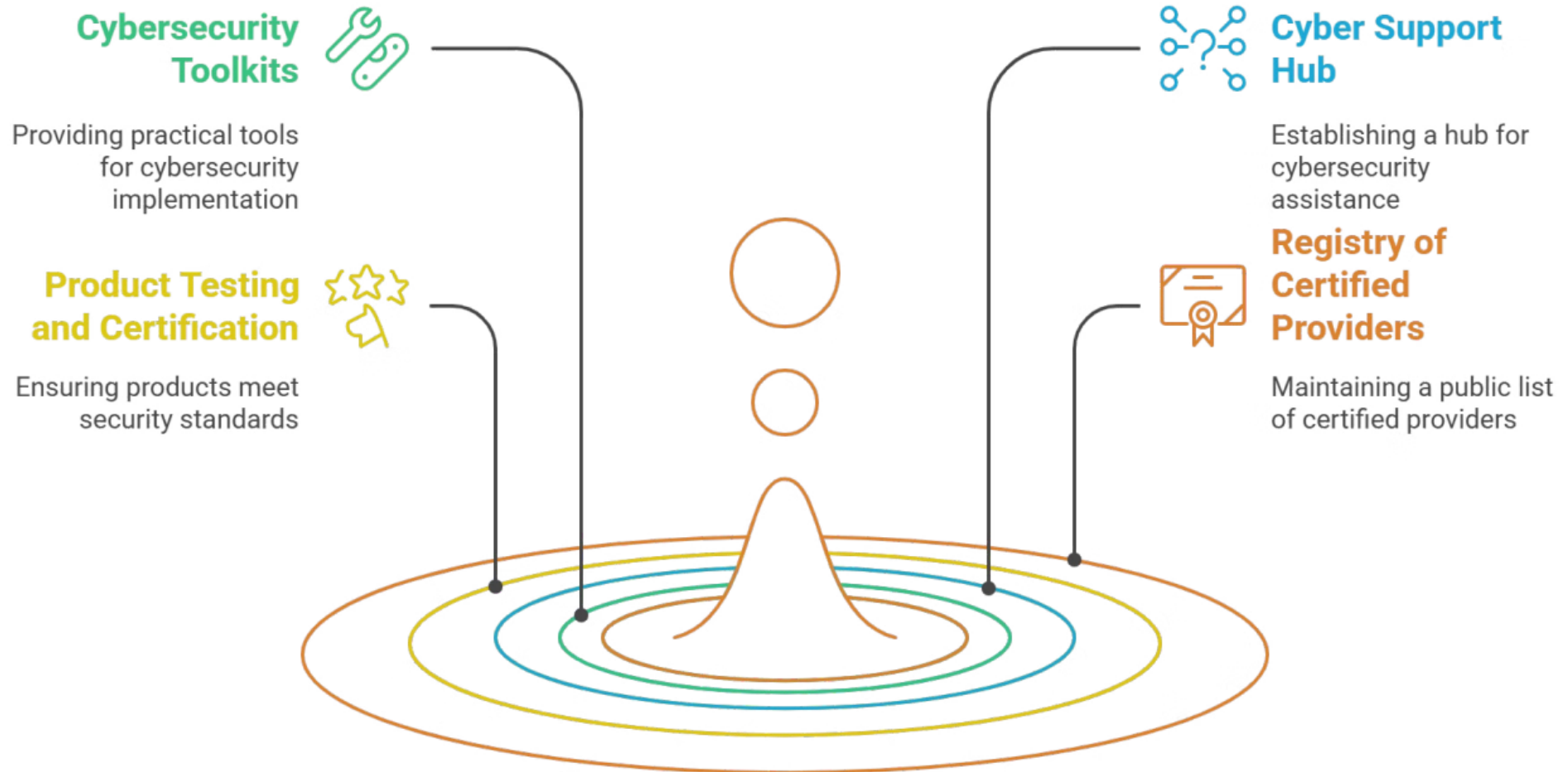
NCSA Leadership

Developing plans for cyber incident management

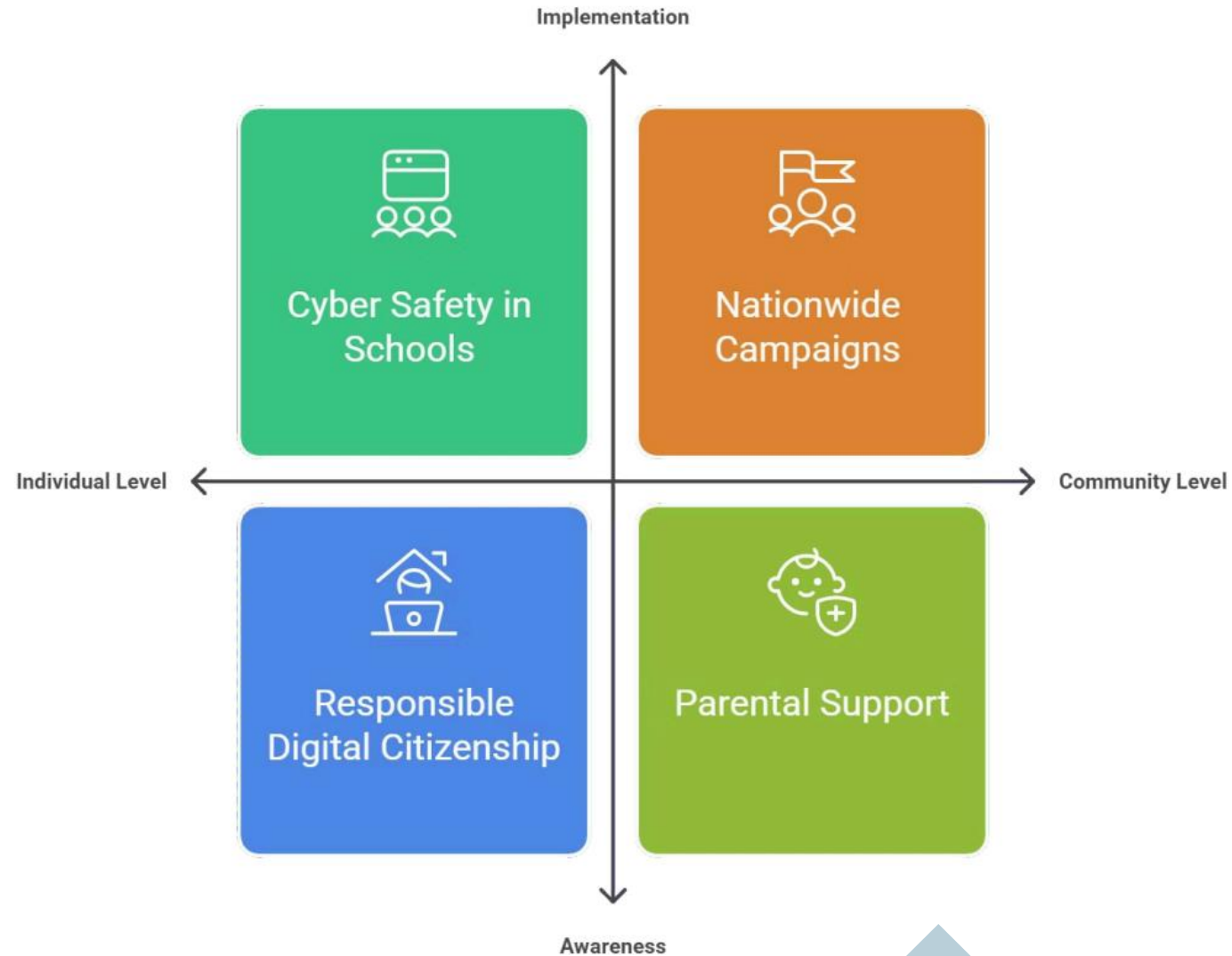

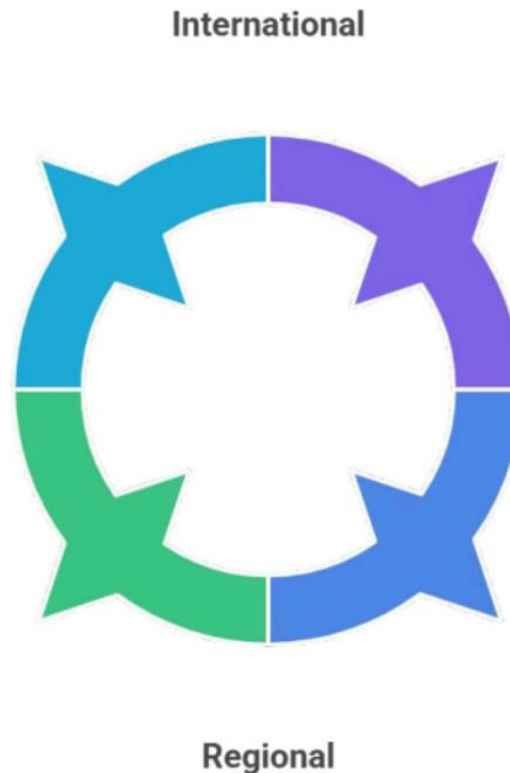
International Legal Cooperation
